Development Issue 2	<p>[Background and current situation]            Due to the growing demand for electricity, which is the result of Zambia's recent strong economic performance, power supply in the country has frequently been limited. Moreover, should demand for the supply of energy in the mining sector increase, the national power supply will be further overloaded, given that the mining sector consumes up to 68% of the national power supply. This would in turn have a drastic negative effect on the performance of the industrial activities and public services. Zambia is an inland country. This means that it relies heavily on its road network to carry out trade activities. However, a large part of the road network in Zambia is poorly maintained, resulting in high expenses when conducting trade, which in turn have created obstacles toward economic growth.</p>				<p>[Strategy]            Invest in stable power supply and rural electrification as a basis for economic growth. Development Issue 3	[Background and current situation] Zambia's population aged under 15 accounts for almost half of its total population, and it is essential that this young generation be developed soundly as they shoulder the future development of Zambia. Meanwhile, reports suggest that Zambia's average life expectancy is 48 years, which is lower than that of the African continent, which is 54 years. Moreover, Zambia scored the lowest marks in mathematics achievement levels of Grade 6, according to the monitoring survey of learning achievement in Southern and Eastern Africa. These statistics demonstrate challenges facing Zambia in access to health, safe water and sanitation as well as the quality of basic education.					[Strategy] Promote sustainable economic growth by developing healthy and qualified human resources through improvement of the quality of basic education, strengthening of health systems and promotion of safe water supply. Support to the education sector will align with Japan's Education Cooperation Policy 2011-2015. Support training of the health workforce and develop physical health assets (infrastructure and equipment) with sustainable management.
