Mr. Seidlitz Nkhonjera, General Manager, MUVI TV, Ms. Mubanga Mulenga, Programs Manager, MUVI TV, Representatives from the Media, Distinguished Guests, Ladies and Gentlemen, It is my honour and pleasure to hand over a Japanese TV program to MUVI TV today.

For the purpose of introducing the Japanese culture and values to the people overseas through TV programs, the Japan Foundation has a scheme to bear the costs of the broadcasting rights fees and of the production of the audio-visual materials.
