INSTRUCTIONS FOR VISA APPLICANTS GOING TO JAPAN <u>AS A VISIT</u>

• Please submit the following:

- 1. Visa Application Form (I-C).
- 2. Your current passport, which must remain valid for at least six months after your departure for Japan.
- 3. Proof of professional ties to your home country, your original National Registration Card, or Driving License.
- 4. **Non-Zambian** nationals must provide a **Work Permit or Residence Permit** which should remain valid for at least six months.
- 5. One Recent colour photograph, (45mm x 35mm), front facing.
- 6. Confirmation of travel schedule (**Itinerary**) or written guarantee from the Travel Agent showing your return date to Zambia.
- 7. A letter from your company giving you leave of absence from work.
- 8. A letter written by yourself stating the places you wish to visit in Japan and the name of the hotel where you will be staying, (Stay plan).
- 9. **Confirmation of accommodation** booked in advance in Japan or written guarantee from your Guarantor to provide accommodation for you in Japan during your period of stay.

[Provided from Japan]

- 10. Letter of Reason for Invitation
- 11. Certificate of residence (with description of his/her family relationship with all family members)

*When the guarantor is a foreign national/Japanese Nation in Japan

- Photocopy of the both sides of the valid Residence card
- Photocopy of his/her passport (including the pages for status items, the record of entry/departure, and permission of residence)

[If the guarantor is to pay the expenses]

- Letter of Guarantee
- Certificate of Employment
- Certificate of Income (Certificate of Tax Payment (Form 2) or copy of the counterfoil of final tax return with the seal of reception of the Tax Office)
- Certificate of residence (with description of his/her family relationship with all family members)
 - 12. You need to prove that you have sufficient funds available in the forms a valid Bank Statement.
 - 13. A **nonrefundable** visa application fee (Cheques or foreign currency not acceptable.)
 - 14. A minimum of five working days is required for a visa to be approved and issued.
 - 15. You are required to apply for your visa in person.

(Note) The required documents shall be valid at the time of visa application, and shall be submitted <u>within three months of their date of issue</u>. The required documents should be submitted in <u>original form</u>.
