Remarks of H.E. Mr. TAKEUCHI Kazuyuki, Ambassador of Japan to the Republic of Zambia, On the Occasion of Media Breakfast Raddison Blu Hotel Tuesday, 19th August 2025

Your role as the press is essential in raising awareness of TICAD's significance in Zambia, in conveying the reality of Japan–Zambia relations, and in amplifying Africa's voice on the global stage. As we approach TICAD 9 next week, I earnestly request your continued cooperation in delivering accurate, constructive, and inspiring coverage.

Ladies and Gentlemen,

I trust that today's discussion will not only deepen your understanding of the TICAD process, but also highlight the tangible impact of Japan's development cooperation in Zambia, the successes we have achieved together, and the opportunities that lie ahead.

Your engagement and accurate reporting will be vital in ensuring that these stories reach the broader public, inspiring further collaboration and mutual understanding. I look forward to working hand in hand with all of you towards the success of TICAD 9, the continued advancement of Japan–Zambia cooperation in every field, and the strengthening of our enduring partnership.
